

## JHS PTO MINUTES

May 11, 2023

**Members Present:** Chelsey Tanke, Staci Randall, Carin Birt, Karmen Gano, Ryan Woods, Kristy Irwin via Zoom

Meeting called to order at 12:11 pm by Chelsey Tanke.

**Principal's Report:** Ryan Woods- Prom is over, had a huge turnout (over 1000 at dance), had no trouble at Post Prom at school. Graduation is coming up- 598 graduates. Seniors are done in one week. Spring sports are entering post season, summer sports starting soon. Multiple track records have been broken. We asked about spending his discretionary fund. We'll use toward the ice cream truck for staff on the last day unless he thinks of something else. Interim superintendent interviews are next week along with interviews for a new athletic director. Full time superintendent search starts next fall or early winter. The new JHS assistant principal starts this summer- school year job, not year round.
